

FREEMAN TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 6
DRILLING OF OIL AND GAS WELLS ORDINANCE

Section 1:

Be it ordained and enacted by the Township Board of the Township of Freeman, County of Clare, State of Michigan, that Freeman Township Ordinance No. 6 is amended as follows:

Section 2:

Pursuant to the existing regulation as stated by the Department of Environment Quality (DEQ) under Michigan's Oil and Gas Regulations. Oil and Gas exploration, drilling, and operating is regulated under the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, as amended (last amended 9/10/2004).

Section 3:

It is further ordained that the Department of Environment Quality is the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the township under this ordinance.

Section 4:

Should the courts declare any provision or section of this ordinance unconstitutional or invalid, then such decision shall affect only the section or provision so passed upon, and shall not affect any other section or part of this ordinance.

Section 5:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance becomes effective thirty (30) days after newspaper publication.
