Sandra Sable, with support from Pat Humphrey moved to limestone Cook ---Monroe to end of cul-de-sac, Larch ----Hemlock to the end, Ridgeway, and Tamarack ---Hemlock to Evergreen. All were in agreement to hold off on Strawberry to Monroe to Mannsiding until we have funds to do the whole road at once. Vote taken- Motion carried.
