

Supervisor Housler called the July 9, 2015 Freeman Township meeting to order at 7:00 pm with the Pledge to the Flag. Present for Roll Call was A. Housler, J. Lackie, S. Sable, R. Wells, P. Humphrey was absent. Twelve citizens were present for this meeting.

The minutes of the June 11, 2015 minutes were approved with no additions or corrections with a motion from R. Wells and second from S. Sable. Vote Taken – Motion carried.

Dale Majewski, Clare County Commissioner, reported that the County Budget is not done and they are still working on it.

September 15<sup>th</sup> Waste Management will have the Hazardous Waste collection from 10:00 am until 2:00 pm, but everyone is advised to get there early because they expect a crowd. This will be done at Northern Oaks, copies will be made of the flyer and set out for the citizens to take.

The Treasurers report was not given because we had not received the monthly bank statement.. Motion to approve check numbers 13957 through 13996 was made by R. Wells and supported by S. Sable. Vote Taken – Motion Carried.

The Deputy Clerk stated that there will be an August 4<sup>th</sup> election and will reflect only one (1) issue for Clare County Voters, Clare County transit will ask for a renewal for operations. Absentee Ballots are available from the Clerk.

Supervisor Housler gave an update on the issue at Windover Lake regarding the stairs built on end of the road right of way and the placement of an in the water docking station for a wave runner. The stairs and the docking station were constructed by the same property owner who did not get permits for either structure. This problem has been turned over to the County Prosecuting Attorney as a criminal infraction. The amount of time this case will consume is not known but we will keep you updated on any information we receive. Conservation officer, Jason will issue tickets for the wave runner and the mooring that is located at the foot of the stairs.

Supervisor Housler also reminded the citizens present at the meeting that there will be a Public Hearing held at the August 13<sup>th</sup> meeting prior to the regular meeting to consider the adoption of Ordinances 33 and 34.

Supervisor Housler stated that he had put a document on the back table “ Questions and Answers” , regarding Special Assessment issues if anyone wanted to read this document it will answer many questions. and is available at the hall for anyone to read. He felt the reading of Page 9 would be very beneficial. If this issue is to be on the ballot as a renewal it has to be on the ballot by 05-31-16 or after that date it would have to be listed as a new millage. The Board will be discussing whether to put our Road Millage Renewal on the ballot for March.

The open top containers are at the Transfer Site and will be there until they are full.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Planning, L. Stevens, stated that the Township and the County does not have any leash laws on the books and that some resolution should be made on this issue. The August Planning meeting will be cancelled due to the election on the same day.

Building, W. Mantej, had 6 Building Permits.

Zoning, H. Logan, had 2 Zoning Permits.

Blight, H. Logan, he is monitoring 6 open cases and has 2 new cases.

A citizen reported an empty mobile home and H. Logan said he would check on this.

Sheyla Young ask if Monroe and Grass Lake will ever be graded.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:23 pm with a motion from R. Wells support from J. Lackie. The next Meeting will be August 13, 2015, Public Hearing and Regular Meeting.
