ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 11

An ordinance to repeal Freeman Township Ordinance No. 11 (Ordinance To Establish The Office Of Ordinance Enforcement Officer).

The Township of Freeman Ordains:

Section 1.

The Freeman Township Ordinance No. 11, known as the "Ordinance To Establish The Office Of Ordinance Enforcement Officer", is hereby repealed. The Freeman Township Ordinance No. 11 is outdated and all existing language, duties and/or references included therein currently exist in the Freeman Township Zoning Ordinance No. 8, Sections 14.01, 14.02 and 14.03 or are enforced by law enforcement agencies.

Section 2.

All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3.


This ordinance becomes effective thirty (30) days after newspaper publication.


