 - 1. Long Term Agenda: None.
 - 2. Proposed New Ordinance No. 41-DRAFT 2: "Code of Ethics for Freeman Township Officials Ordinance".
 - a. Mr. lousier stated that the proposed Code of Ethics Ordinance is still pending with the Board.
 - 3. Control No. of Trailers on a Single Lot or Property:
 - a. Mr. Housler stated that this issue has resolved itself and can be removed from the Planning Commission agenda.
 - 4. Possible Re-Zoning of Ag zoned properties to Rec./Conserv. or Res. where Ag zoning criteria does not allow for splitting of properties of 20 Acres or less. Possible change the acreage criteria.
 - a. Mr. Logan stated that as the Zoning Ordinance stands now Ag zoned properties cannot be split if 20 acres or less without getting a valiance from the Board of Appeals, and that we cannot rezone after a single Ag split to fit Rec./Conserv. or Res. as this would constitute "spot zoning" which is illegal.
 - b. Mr. Maas asked if this has been done successfully in the past and Mr. Logan said he believes so.
 - c. It was discussed to change the criteria for Ag property splits to 50 acres instead of the existing 20 acres, but all agreed that this would probably lead to a cascade effect of changing criteria for property splits.
 - d. All Planning Commission members present agreed it would be in the best interest of Freeman Township to leave the Ag property 20 acre criteria as is and if a property owner wished to split a section off they would still need to go through the Freeman Township Board of Appeals.
